Guidance for completing the form:

1. It is a legal duty to provide written notification of your interests and the information provided must be correct to the best of your knowledge.
2. Failure to complete this form or to knowingly provide false information could lead to prosecution.
3. The form relates to the whole authority area, not just the ward which you represent.
4. **Complete all sections, if you do not have an interest in a particular area, you must write 'NONE'.**
5. This form must be completed and returned within 28 days of election.
6. If your circumstances change or you subsequently declare an interest at a meeting which is not detailed below, you must submit an amendment to this form within 28 days of becoming aware of a change or making that declaration.
7. There are 2 parts to the form:
 - Part 1 contains disclosable pecuniary interests as prescribed by The Relevant Authorities (Disclosable Pecuniary Interests) Regulations 2012;
 - Part 2 contains Other interests agreed by the Council.
8. Part 1 relates both to your interests and those of your spouse or civil partner (or a person you are living with as a husband or wife or a person you are living with as if they were a civil partner).
